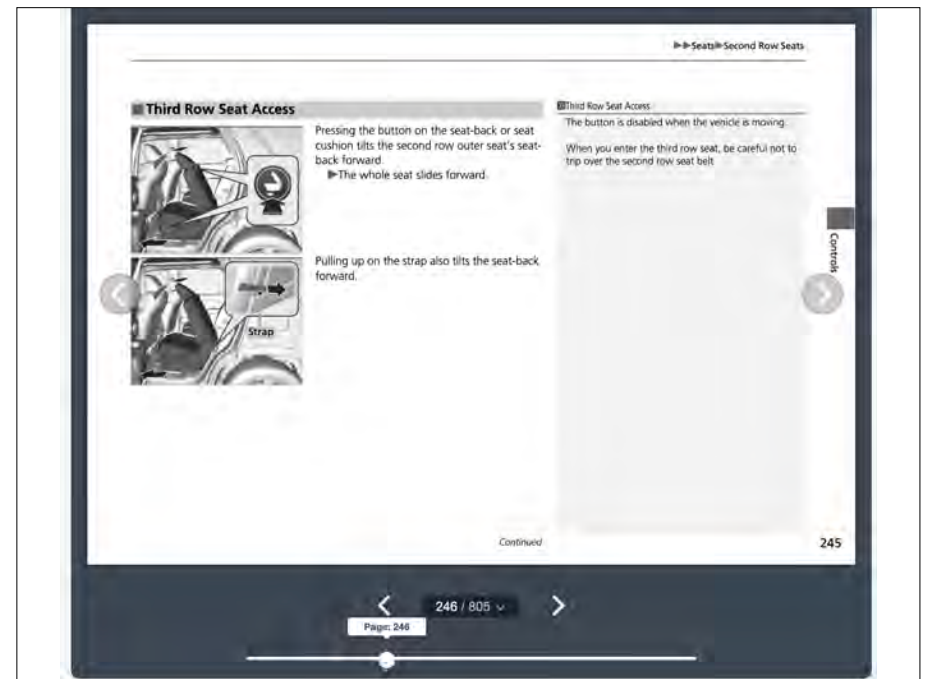
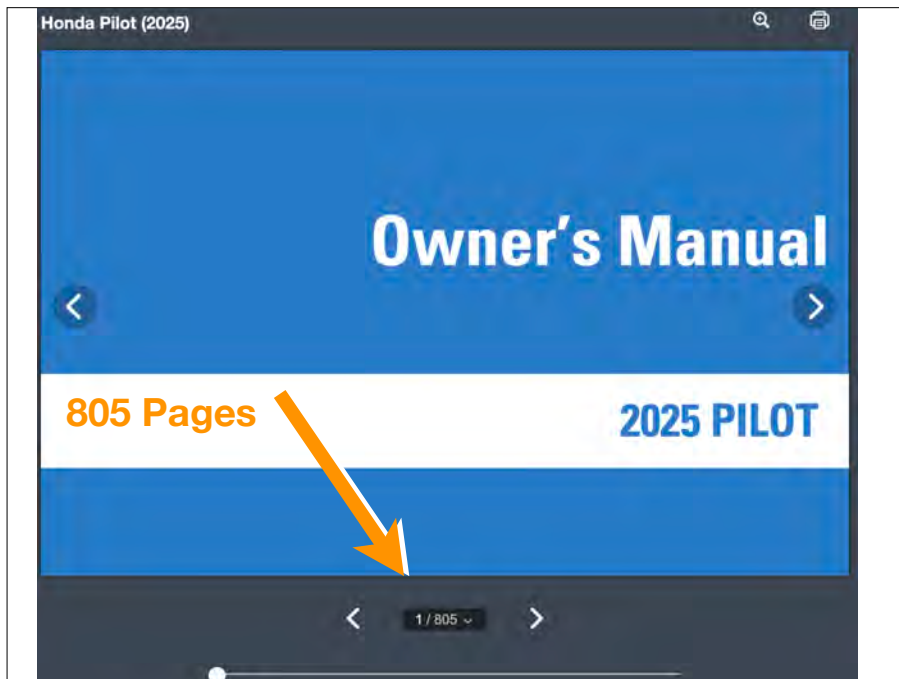

Storing the Flat Tire



- Put the flat tire in the tire storage bag provided with your vehicle.
- The tire storage bag is in the tool case.
- Knot the top of the tire storage bag.
- Securely put the jack, wheel nut wrench, jack handle bar, and box wrench back in the tool case.



- Bore through the bag, and pass the holding belt through the hole of the bag and the wheel of the flat tire as shown.



- Place the cargo floor lid in the lower position.
- Place the flat tire in the cargo area, and thread the belt through the rear anchor as shown.
- Pass the belt through the ring, and tighten the belt to secure the flat tire in place.

Loose items can fly around the interior in a crash and can seriously injure the occupants.

Store the wheel, jack, and tools securely before driving.

If the Keyless Remote Battery is Weak

If the beeper sounds, the **To start**, touch start button with emblem side of remote message appears on the driver information interface, the **ENGINE START/STOP** button flashes, and the engine won't start, start the engine as follows:



- Press the **ENGINE START/STOP** button.
 - The beeper sounds and the **ENGINE START/STOP** button flashes for about 30 seconds.
- Touch the center of the **ENGINE START/STOP** button with the **H** logo on the keyless remote while the **ENGINE START/STOP** button is flashing. The buttons on the keyless remote should be facing you.
 - The beeper sounds, and the **ENGINE START/STOP** button stays on for about 10 seconds.
- Depress the brake pedal and press the **ENGINE START/STOP** button while the **ENGINE START/STOP** button is on.
 - The engine starts.
 - If you don't depress the pedal, the mode will change to **ACCESSORY**.

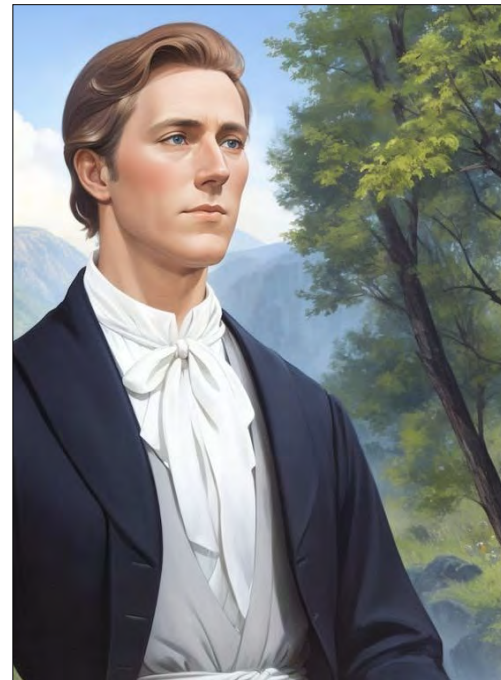
“I was at this time in my fifteenth year” (JS–History 1:7).

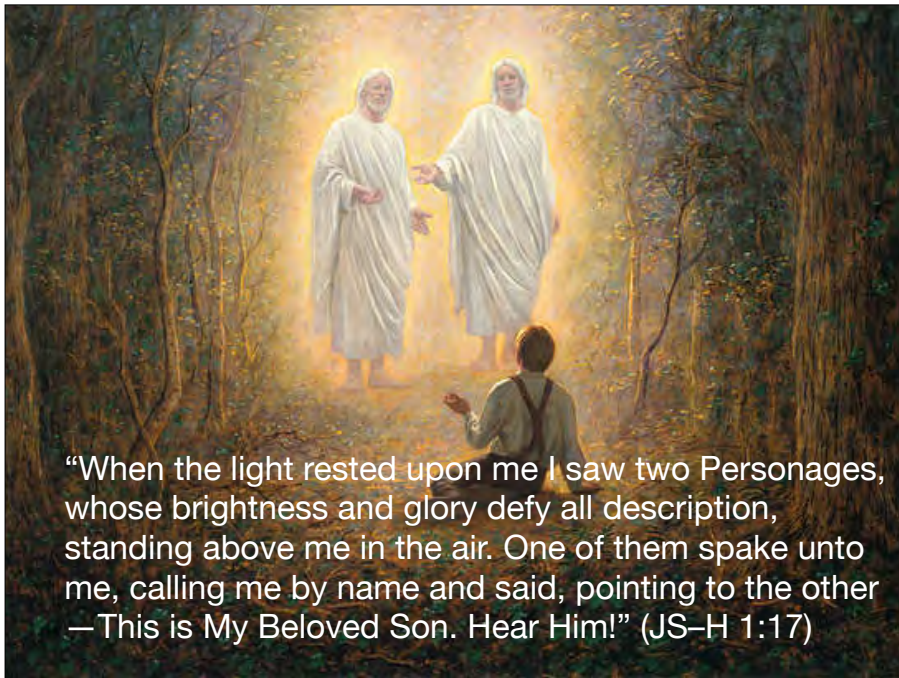

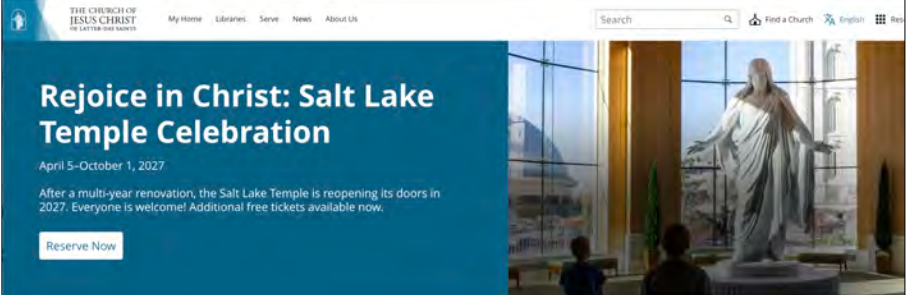

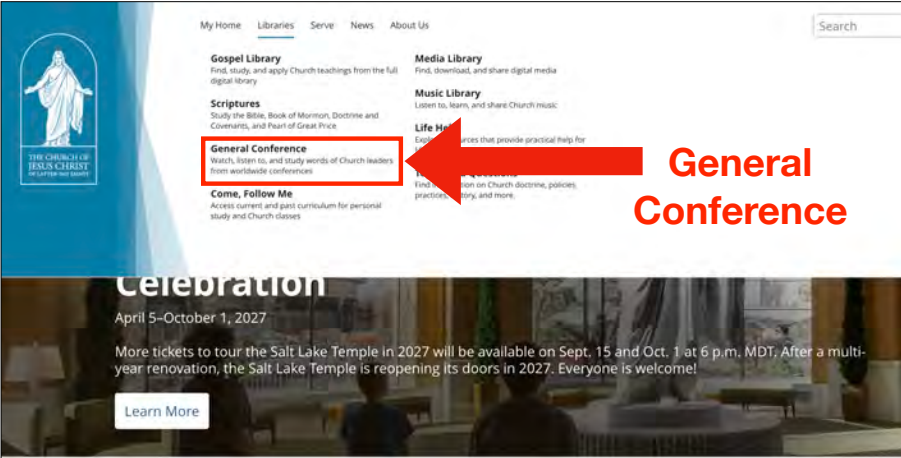
